

### English

In English, our key text will be Super worm and Traction Man. These books link to our theme of Heroes. We will be retelling and creating our own narrative based on these books.

### History

In History, we will be learning about Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale. We will be learning about their lives and how important they were within medicine.

### Music

We will be using Sing Up to practice our music skills.

### Computing

In Computing we will be creating our own animated stories using purple mash.

### Art and Design

Our topic is Cooking and Nutrition. We will be trying a range of different fruit and vegetables before we design and make our own smoothies.

### PE

In P.E our topics are team building and net and wall games.

## We Are Connected

### Science

In Science we will be learning about animals including humans before moving onto the seasons of Spring and Summer. We will be investigating several inquiry questions, such as 'what changes take place between spring and summer?'

### Geography

In Geography we will be thinking about Europe. We will learn the 7 continents and 5 oceans before zooming in on Europe.

### Religious Education

In RE this term the children will be learning about Salvation. Children will learn about the Easter story before thinking about the different ways that some Christians might choose to celebrate Easter.

### Maths

Our Maths topics this term will be focused on Place Value within 50 before moving on to measure (length, height, volume and mass).

### RHE

In RHE our topic is 'Healthy Me'. In this unit the children will get a chance to think about how to make healthy choices, and why this is important. We will think about safety when using medicines and when crossing the road.
