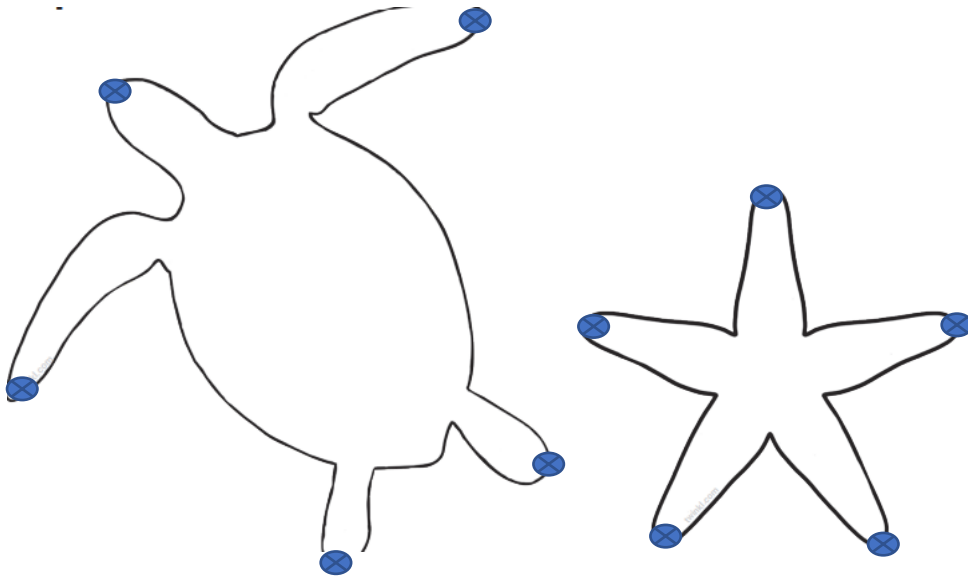


Maths - plotting coordinates and translating images
