- Send their child to school each day punctually, suitably clothed, fed, rested and equipped and ready to learn;
- Inform the school of any concerns related to the child's learning behaviour and learning, including attending meetings when requested;
- Attend parent consultations to discuss progress and next learning steps;
- Support the school's approach to e-safety and will not upload or add any pictures, video or text online that could upset, offend or threaten the safety of any member of the school community. - Encourage pupils to show respect for school staff, fellow pupils, school property and school environment; and
- Adhere to the school's parking promise.
