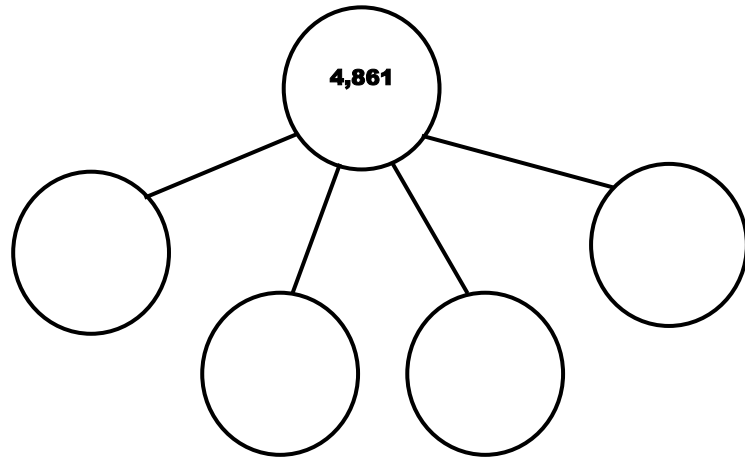

Prepositions A word that describes the position of something, the time it happened or the way it is done, such as: under, between, on, after, by	Conjunctions A word that connects, phrases or sentences, such as: and because but for, if, or
