

English

In English, our key texts will be 'Old Bear' and 'Peace at Last'. The children will be beginning to write simple sentences to create a Narrative.

History

Our topic this term is called Changes over time. The children will begin their history learning by learning about how things they are familiar with have changed over time such as themselves, the school, toys and transport.

Music

Our music topic is Menu Song . Children will be exploring rhythm using percussion instruments and their own body.

Computing

In Computing we will be learning all about how we can keep safe when using the internet and how to log into Purple Mash.

Art and Design

Our topic is Drawing: Make your mark. The children will explore how to create patterns using different lines and marks.

Science

In science we will be learning about materials. By the end of the unit, the children will have learnt to sort materials, identify properties of materials and explain how materials can change.

Who We Are

Geography

In Geography we will be learning about our local area – Tonbridge. We will compare different types of houses, look at the features of Tonbridge and think about the different types of jobs in Tonbridge.

Religious Education

In RE this term the children will be learning about God and Prayer. Children will think about different ways that Christians can show forgiveness and love. The children will have the opportunity to complete a range of activities to consolidate their understanding.

Maths

Our Maths topics this term will be focused on Place Value within 10. We will be looking at sorting and counting objects, as well as calculating one more and one less. Later in the term we will look at using number lines and learning number bonds to ten.

RHE

In RHE our topic is Being Me in My World. In this unit the children will get a chance to look at what makes them feel special and safe, their role in the classroom and different consequences (both positive and negative).

PE

In P.E the children will be learning Ball Skills and Gymnastics.
